(Eustis, FL)... Bay Street Players will hold open auditions for **THE FULL MONTY, *The Musical*** on Monday December 1 and Tuesday, December 2 at 7:30 PM. The auditions will take place at the State Theatre in downtown Eustis, 109 North Bay Street. The production will be presented February 6-March 1, 2009.

Artistic Director **David Clevinger** and Musical Director **Jim Rhinehart** will be casting various roles for women and men including one boy approximately ten years old. The role of “Noah 'Horse' Simmons” has been cast. All parts require singing and some dancing.

Newcomers are welcome. Those auditioning are asked to prepare an upbeat musical selection and to bring sheet music in their key. An accompanist will be provided. In addition, some may be asked to read selections from the script. Anyone not interested in performing onstage is invited to join our team of volunteers and to learn of backstage opportunities needed for this production.

THE FULL MONTY is a musical with a book by Terrence McNally and music and lyrics by David Yazbek. The plot follows the stories of out of work steel workers in Buffalo, New York, as they come up with a bold way to make some cash for their families. In the process, the characters find renewed self-esteem, the importance of friendship, and the ability to have fun.
